### Definitions of Membership

Type	Age & Criteria
One Parent Family	1 Adult Dependent children age 0-25
Family	2 Adults (cohabitating & combining incomes and expenses) Dependent children age 0-25
Senior Family	2 Adults (cohabitating & combining incomes and expenses) One adult must be at least 62 and over. Includes dependents ages 0-25 living in the same household
