OUR CAMPS

Mini Marland - Mini Marland is located on the beautiful campus of our YMCA. This wooded in-town camp location allows us the opportunity to engage young campers in a traditional camp setting surrounded by trees and along the shores of the Mousam river. This location provides all the feels of a deep woods Maine camp with the safety and security of our YMCA nearby if needed for inclement weather or extreme heat.

Big Marland - Big Marland is located on over 30 acres of wooded shoreline along Bunganut Lake in Lyman. Campers are offered the opportunity to engage in all the traditional day camp activities including art exploration, hiking, sports and games, archery, canoeing, and more. The close proximity to our YMCA allows us to ability to maximize our time on campus at Bunganut Lake Park in Lyman and surround campers with the beauty of the great Maine woods.

Focused Fun @ Muscatawa - Focused Fun @ Muscatawa is located on a private waterfront property on the shores of Kennebunk Pond in Lyman. This new camp facility is provided by a new partnership with the owner of the former boy scout camp, Muscatawa. This partnership had given us the opportunity to offer program specific camps where campers can focus on one area of interest for an entire week. The camp facilities include a private waterfront, miles of hiking trails, open fields, former boy scout camp buildings, indoor shelters for focused work and learning, and opportunities to get out of inclement weather or extreme heat if needed.



Focused Fun Sports Camp - Focused Fun Sports Camps are 1/2 camp opportunities for campers looking to focus on the development of their individual skills in either basketball or soccer. Using the open fields and courts at our YMCA we will be able to provide campers the opportunity to spend time this summer working their individual skills to further enhance their soccer or basketball skills. These half day camps will include the opportunity to swim in the Y pool following each camp session.

Mini-Marland

Is an introductory program into the world of YMCA camping. Nestled into the woods on our YMCA campus along the Mousam way trail and the shores of the Mousam River, Camp Mini-Marland gives campers the feel of being part of a summer camp in the woods of Maine. Our Mini-Marland program utilizes all of the natural landscape around our YMCA to provide daily opportunities for campers to go hiking, create amazing works of art, build forts and fairy houses, and develop physical skills in sports and games.

Having the YMCA facility to lean on allows us to support the needs of young campers during days of inclement weather or extreme heat. Each day campers are given the opportunity to swim in the YMCA pool. The safety and security of our YMCA aquatic facility allows campers the ability to feel safe over coming hesitations around the water and confident swimmer a place to become stronger swimmers without the pressure of a large open water environment.

Mini Marland is a wonderful blend of a traditional summer camp program and the nurturing environment of a summer preschool program.

Big Marland

The cornerstone program of our camp offerings again this summer. This is our very first camp program offered more than 50 years ago on Ell Pond in South Sanford and now the beautiful 30+ acres of Bunganut Lake Park in Lyman. This foundational camp program continues to provide campers with the true feel of traditional summer camp located in the deep woods of Maine. Our camp facility allows our campers the opportunity to enjoy a variety of wonderful activities such as canoeing, archery, hiking, swimming, fishing, sports and games, arts and crafts, and much more. Each day we gather as an entire camp family in the lake front amphitheater to share songs, stories, and to create a camp culture that is inclusive, supportive, and memorable.

Our choice-based program is designed to allow campers the opportunity to have some voice and choice in their camp day. This program structure allows campers the opportunity to engage in their favorite activities more, and limit engagement in less preferred ones. When campers are given the ability to make choices that best suit them it is proven that the quality of each camper experience grows. This program structure allows campers to be in groups with like minded peers whose interests align to enhance the experience for all.

Transportation to and from Big Marland is provided daily from our YMCA campus in Sanford. We use our own full size bus and partner with other local bussing businesses to provide safe, secure, and professional transportation. East & West Camp busses are scheduled to leave the Y at 8:15am and North and South busses leave at 9am. The return time of each group will be 3:15pm and 4:00pm.

This 5-day experience is sure to connect your budding artist with other like-minded peers and adults who can guide and inspire the next phase of the artist expression During each camp day campers will have the opportunities to enjoy a recreational swim or chill time with peers and staff and learn a new game or play an old favorite.
